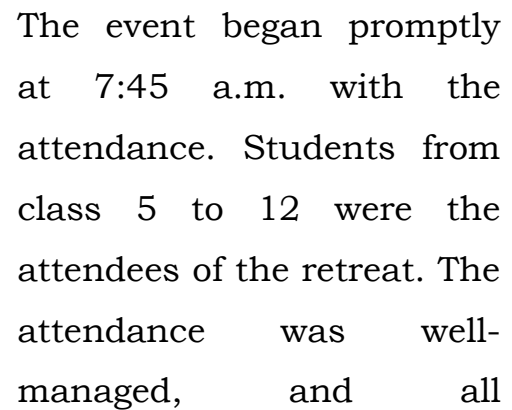
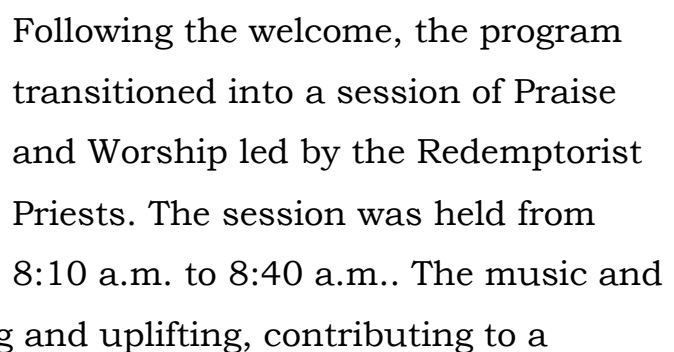
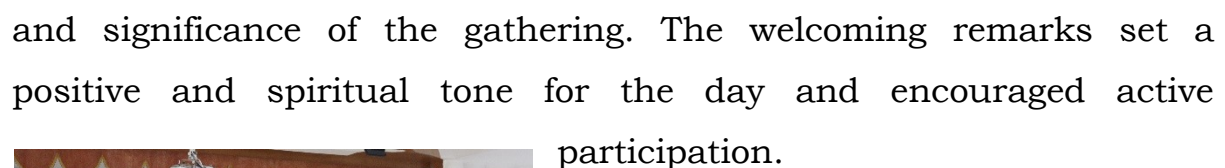


## Date: 27-07-2024
